



YouthLinks

... connects volunteers and youth virtually

For all engagement involving SOS Children's Villages Youth, there is the opportunity to virtually connect via the platform YouthLinks.

... is commonly known for the option of video calls.

Skype allows for participants all over the world to virtually connect face-to-face. Skype is a good alternative to personal meetings and provides an uncomplicated way of communicating.

ZOOM

... is a platform offering the possibilities of having video chats, conferences and online presentations.



Next to the more business focused trials, Zoom also offers a free basic plan for a more personal use. Zoom can be accessed via computer, smartphone or tablet.

WhatsApp ...

... is a widely known messenger app for chatting but can also be used for (video) calls.

The messenger function of WhatsApp offers a convenient way of quickly checking in with others. WhatsApp is mainly used via smartphone. There are also applications for computer and tablet, however, those only work if the app is also installed on a phone.

One-to-One Mentoring

... one-to-one mentoring sessions can easily be hosted on the platform.





... there is a supplementary option for group training sessions, allowing bigger groups to interact virtually.



TED & TED-Ed ...

... offers free access to plenty motivating and enriching presentations and speeches.



To cover current need, the well known TED format developed TED-Ed: an educational format, offering students, teachers and adults direct access to videos with educational value. There is also business-related content available, mostly focusing on the development of various soft skills.

... is a free learning platform for all different agegroups with plenty of options in several categories.

To highlight separately, you will additionally find a sector with guidance for college admissions, careers, information in relation to entrepreneurship and further. Mostly, the classes are available in video-format, engaging a school-like learning.

Kahoot!...

... is a free software for creating quizzes which can in a further step be shared and played via internet.



People can access the quiz via a link on their computer, smartphone or tablet. At the end of every game, there is also an official ranking. Experience shows that the Quiz-format has a really motivating effect.

Kahoot! is free of charge for teachers and students (simple selection menu asking) about this).

Word Press

... offers you the opportunity to create a blog – and improve your writing and creativity skills.



The webpage not only offers you to host your texts for free but also gives you many options in terms of design. It is easy to use and can encourage users to engage in creating texts, also via smartphone. For example, volunteers could get creative and share job-insights or their own career stories with the youths.

Anchor ...

... is a platform through which you can create, distribute, and monetize podcasts



It can be accessed from any device and is free of charge. It is a great opportunity for youths to engage virtually: while creating a podcast, one is directly exposed to modern and virtual forms of sharing information and insights.
